**ORDINANCE AMENDING THE BOROUGH OF CHESILHURST'S 2020
SALARY ORDINANCE**

WHEREAS, on March 12, 2020, the Borough of Chesilhurst (Borough) adopted its 2020 Salary Ordinance, setting forth the various salaries, hourly rates, and per diem rates for Borough employees and officials, and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council has appointed an Interim Deputy Municipal Court Administrator by Resolution No. 2020-145 on September 3, 2020, setting forth an annual salary of \$34,500.00, and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Council of the Borough Of Chesilhurst that the following amendment shall be made to the Borough of Chesilhurst's 2020 Salary Ordinance

The annual salary of an Interim Deputy Municipal Court Administrator shall hereby be established in the amount of \$34,500.00, retroactive to September 3, 2020, and shall be paid on a Bi-weekly basis

All other provisions contained within the 2020 Salary Ordinance shall remain valid and in effect, and are not amended by this ordinance

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage, approval, and publication, as provided by law.

WHEREAS, THE BOROUGH OF CHESILHURST'S TRASH TRUCKS HAVE RECENTLY BROKEN DOWN AND HAVE CREATED AN EMERGENCY SITUATION THAT REQUIRES AN ALTERNATIVE METHOD OF COLLECTING THE BOROUGH RESIDENT'S TRASH; AND

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:65-1, ET SEQ ("UNIFORM SHARED SERVICES AND CONSOLIDATION ACT") PERMITS TWO LOCAL UNITS TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR ANY SERVICE WHICH ANY PARTY TO THE AGREEMENT IS EMPOWERED TO RENDER WITHIN ITS JURISDICTION; AND

WHEREAS, THE BOROUGH OF RUNNEMEDE AND CHESILHURST AGREE THAT THEIR MUTUAL PUBLIC PURPOSE IN PROVIDING FOR PUBLIC SAFETY AND THEIR BEST INTEREST IN PROVIDING FOR ECONOMIES AND EFFICIENCIES IN EFFECTIVE GOVERNMENT SERVICE WILL BE PROMOTED BY THE EXECUTION AND DELIVERY OF THIS SHARED SERVICES AGREEMENT PURSUANT TO THE POWERS CONFERRED BY THE UNIFORM SHARED SERVICES AND CONSOLIDATION ACT, AND

WHEREAS, A CERTIFICATION OF AVAILABILITY OF FUNDS IS HEREBY MADE BY THE CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER FOR TRASH AND RECYCLING SERVICES PROVIDED BY THE BOROUGH OF RUNNEMEDE WHICH SHALL BE CHARGED AGAINST BUDGET LINE ITEM-SANITATION- OTHER EXPENSE, ACCOUNT NUMBER 0-01-26-305-021 IN THE AMOUNT OF \$., AND

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE MAYOR AND BOROUGH COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF CHESILHURST THAT THE BOROUGH SHALL ENTER INTO THE ATTACHED SHARED SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH THE BOROUGH OF RUNNEMEDE TO PROVIDE TRASH AND RECYCLING COLLECTION SERVICES ON AN EMERGENCY BASIS AT A RATE OF \$100.00 PER HOUR AND \$34.00 PER HOUR FOR PUBLIC WORKS DRIVER **SUBJECT TO FAVORABLE REVIEW BY THE BOROUGH SOLICITOR, AND**

**SHARED SERVICES AGREEMENT BY AND BETWEEN THE BOROUGH OF
RUNNEMEDE AND THE BOROUGH OF CHESILHURST, CONTY OF CAMDEN,
STATE OF NEW JERSEY FOR TRASH AND RECYLING COLLECTION ON AN
EMERGENCY BASIS**

THIS AGREEMENT, dated on this ____ day of _____, 2020, constitutes a Uniformed Shared Services Agreement pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40:65-1 et seq. entered into by and between the Borough of Runnemede, a body politic and corporate of the State of New Jersey with offices located at 24 N. Black Horse Pike, Runnemede, New Jersey and the Borough of Chesilhurst, a body politic and corporate of the State of New Jersey with offices located at 201 Grant Avenue, Chesilhurst, New Jersey.

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, the Borough of Runnemede (hereinafter “Runnemede”) and the Borough of Chesilhurst (“Chesilhurst”) are municipal entities organized under the laws of the State of New Jersey; and

WHEREAS, Runnemede and Chesilhurst wish to enter into an Agreement whereby Runnemede will supply service of a truck(s) with driver(s) to Chesilhurst for the purpose of trash and/or recycling collection on an emergency basis; and

WHEREAS, by negotiations previously had between Runnemede and Chesilhurst, the terms and provisions hereafter set forth were determined and agreed thereto; and

WHEREAS, Runnemede and Chesilhurst intend by virtue of this document to set forth the terms and conditions of this agreement; and

WHEREAS, the proper and respective public officials are or will be authorized to execute this Shared Service Agreement pursuant to Resolutions of their respective governing bodies, attached hereto and made part of this agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, AND IN CONSIDERATION of the mutual promises set forth herein, the parties hereto agree as follows:

1. SCOPE

- 1.1. Runnemede will supply service of a truck(s) with driver(s) for the purpose of trash and/or recycling collection on an emergency basis.
- 1.2. Chesilhurst will supply a drop off point for trash and recycling. Runnemede will be transporting the trash and/or recycling to the Pollution Control Financing Authority of Camden County.
- 1.3. Chesilhurst shall remain responsible for all tipping fees.

2. TERM

The services to be furnished hereunder shall commence immediately upon approval of both governing bodies and last for one (1) year thereafter. The service agreement shall automatically renew for successive twelve (12) month periods thereafter, unless sixty (60) days written notice by either party to the other of the intent to terminate said agreement. Upon receipt of such notice to terminate, this agreement shall expire at the end of the current term and shall become null and void and of no further legal effect.

3. PAYMENT

Chesilhurst agrees to pay Runnemede a rate of \$100 per hour for the use of the truck and \$34 per hour for the Public Works Repairer/Driver for the services described herein. The rate is based on time to and from Runnemede to Chesilhurst.

4. AUDIT

Pursuant to the Single Audit Act of 1984, Chesilhurst and Runnemede agree to allow the other's agents to examine any and all records relevant to this Agreement and shall make available upon demand at a reasonable time and place for the purpose of auditing the records, reports and documents relative to this Agreement.

5. INDEMNIFICATION

Runnemede and Chesilhurst shall indemnify and hold each other harmless and defend each other, its elected officials, employees, officers and agents from and against all liability, claims, suits, losses, damages, costs and demands, on account of bodily injury, including death or property damage, arising out of or connect with the performance of the services under this Agreement.

The execution and delivery of this Agreement shall not be construed to confer any right of action against either municipality on behalf of the other or on behalf of any other person, natural or otherwise, for any failure, neglect or breach of any term, covenant or condition thereof. The Agreement and all of its terms, conditions and provisions are solely for the benefit of Chesilhurst and Runnemede, and it is understood and agreed between the parties hereto that the sole remedy of either Runnemede or Chesilhurst in the event of any failure or breach of this Agreement shall be the termination hereof.

6. NOTICES

All notices hereunder shall be in writing and sent Certified Mail, Return Receipt Requested for the Borough of Chesilhurst to the Borough Clerk, 201 Grant Avenue, Chesilhurst, New Jersey and for the Borough of Runnemede to the Borough Clerk, Borough of Runnemede, 24 N. Black Horse Pike, Runnemede, New Jersey.


7. MISCELLANEOUS

- 7.1. No one party may assign this Agreement without the written consent of all others.
- 7.2. This Agreement sets forth the entire understanding of the parties hereto with respect to the transactions contemplated herein. No change or modification of this Agreement shall be valid unless the same shall be in writing, duly authorized and signed by all the parties hereto.
- 7.3. In the event that any provision of this Agreement shall, for any reason, be determined to be invalid, illegal, or unenforceable in any respect, the parties hereto shall negotiate in good faith and agree to such amendments, modifications, or supplements of, or to this Agreement, or such other appropriate actions as shall, to the maximum extent practicable in light of such determination, implement and give effect to the intentions of the parties as reflected herein. All other provisions of the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.
- 7.4. The parties acknowledge that this Agreement was prepared under New Jersey law and shall therefore be interpreted under the laws of the State of New Jersey.
- 7.5. This Agreement may be executed in any number of counterparts, each of which, when so executed and delivered, shall be deemed an original, and all of which taken together shall constitute one and the same Agreement. Delivery of an executed counterpart of this Agreement by facsimile shall be equally as effective as delivery of a manually executed counterpart. Any Party hereto delivering an executed counterpart of this Agreement by facsimile shall also deliver a manually executed counterpart, but the failure to do so shall not affect the validity, enforceability or binding effect of the counterpart executed and delivered by facsimile.
- 7.6. This section and any other headings contained in this Agreement are for references only and shall not affect the meaning and interpretation of this Agreement.
