Rent Control

The Rent Control Board did meet in the Month of May. There was a brief discussion about the recent \$15.00 rent increase at Garden Homes. The Board was asked if there was a way to freeze the rents for citizens of Chesilhurst who are on Public Assistance. The Board will investigate this with the assistance of the solicitor to see what can legally be done.
